**NARRATIVE**

On 08/25/2023, at 1611 hours, I (**Officer Black #945**) was dispatched to **219 W. Grand Ave.** for a dog bite.

When I arrived, I contacted the **victim, Stephen Joseph Guidone DOB: 04/13/1944**, who told me about the following in substance: On today's date, at approximately 1600 hours, Guidone was walking west bound on the north sidewalk. As he approached four juveniles walking a dog on the sidewalk, he noticed a female juvenile (N/F/D) was holding onto the dog's leash. As Guidone passed the group, the dog lunged up and towards him unprovoked. The dog bit him on the left forearm, causing two puncture wounds and bleeding. The juveniles pulled the dog back and away from Guidone.

I contacted the **dog owner, Mary Cathrine Fish-Glennan** who had arrived at the location and told me about the following in substance: Mary is the owner of the **2 ½ year old brown male Ridgeback named Logan (tag #5041)**. Her son, **Logan** called and advised Logan had bitten someone. She rushed to the scene and put Logan in her vehicle. She stood by as ESPD Paramedics (**Rescue 31**) tended to the victim's wounds.

I spoke to Lukas who told me the following: Lukas was walking his dog eastbound on the north sidewalk with three other friends. They were playing with Logan, and he was excited. Lukas needed to grab something out of his backpack and gave Logan's leash to a female friend (N/F/D). As they walked past the victim, Logan jumped up and bit the victim. Lukas took control of Logan and called his mother.

Mary took Logan home without incident.
