It is a great place to have all things in one area and as you stated in the Coffee with the Principal, all sports would be in the link. School Administration was aware and did nothing to rectify it.
- 3.) Most of the meets and our home course is Westchester. There are parents and students that can not only see the players tee off on Hole 1 but see them ending on Hole 9 because of the snack bar and patio area.

- 1.) Our Highs School has three Administration Positions, all three fairly new, and I am going to be brutally honest, but you three are dropping the ball.
- 2.) Golf, being typically a sport of privilege and male dominance, has changed and if you look at any Golf Tournament (British Open, Masters, Invitationals All with paying spectators), I take offense to the fact our Girls Golf Schedule was not posted They are Eagles and should be treated with the same as any other sport. Coaches do their job, but I am quite frankly disturbed Administration does not take any accountability to rectify and you should be a support to the Coaches.
- 3.) You declined to have a parent at the meeting and the school provided no written parameters to the JV and Varsity girls.

Good morning all,

As a parent of one of the boys golf team members, Lukas da Silva, I would first and foremost like to thank everyone involved in bringing back the girls and boys golf team. We are very excited for the opportunity for the kids to be able to participate in the program.

As an avid golfer myself who has been playing the Lakes for 10+ years, and who followed the conversion to TopGolf closely there are a couple of outstanding questions I would like to get clarity on. I am hoping the answers can be provided here, or if not, if you can kindly point me in the right direction of who to reach out to.

My questions pertain to the ability for the high school golfers to play and hit balls at Top Golf at a discounted rate. This is something that was discussed all along and I would like to know if there is now an established process for our kids to get affordable access to play the Lakes on days / times when the team does not have scheduled practice. Most local courses participate in the Youth On Course program where \$5 green fees are made available. Prior to TopGolf taking over there was a monthly card available for kids but to my knowledge no such program is available. The level of dedication of our girls and boys team will result in many of them seeking out playing opportunities outside of the team practice hours so getting a clear understanding of what agreements are in place in a timely manner is much needed. Westchester has been a great partner / supporter to our kids and it would be great for El Segundo if the kids could be awarded equal access to The Lakes at affordable prices.

any notification of the details of the meeting (which would have come from El Segundo by way of the principal) as a courtesy to circle and close this chapter, I find myself inquiring why my daughter told me the Girls Golf Team could not use the putting or the chipping green. First, any golfer knows, putting is half the game, literally. El Segundo Girls Golf Coach, Lauren Ryker a former Topgolf Associate, refuses to follow the guidelines put in place for booking times to use the facility, both the Venue and The Lakes. The booking processes that we have in place are so that we may accommodate the many requests that come Topgolf's way. The Teams from El Segundo are a top priority for Topgolf. It's never been about money when giving back to the community. Topgolf is not the ONE standing in the way of the El Segundo Girls Golf Team and their ability to use the facility. Hello all! I wanted to thank Mr. Slack for showing some genuine interest in his daughter and our ESHS girls golf team. I also what to thank those who have helped get the girls team to where it is today! I have been on the forefront supporting and growing the game of golf in El Segundo for many years. In specific, my experience in attempting to further girls and women's golf here in El Segundo continues to be challenging.

Since Topgolf opened, I have been in various conversations and negotiations not only to ensure what was contracted for our juniors happened, but also to see what greater support TopGolf could give to a 1st ever girls golf program. In the teams first season we were met with extremely high priced quotes for fundraisers, a small discount for course usage and very limited venue access. Not to mention that all of that could be canceled anytime due to facility buyouts. At times, the girls would be shuffled to different areas of the venue after it was agreed that they would only practice on the 1st floor close to the practice area to limit exposure to alcohol use etc... "Additional support" for the team would have to be revisited after Topgolf had "turned a profit." It would appear by all metrics that TopGolf has made more than a little profit (to my understanding, El Segundo Topgolf achieved the most revenue of any TopGolf in the country except for the Vegas location).

Needless to say the progression of girls golf in El Segundo has been difficult and there will be more golf teams and programs entering the mix in the short term future. In addition to the girls team, we now have a large ES High School boys golf team starting in the Spring, as well as a middle school "developmental program" we have been working to develop.

I am cc'ing a few more sources who have either assisted in or followed the progression of this subject: Josh Alpert, PGA (long time El Segundo resident, Youth Academy Coach to several Gundo players and in our greater South Bay community, also the SCPGA Section Player Development Chair over the past 2 years) Nikki Gatch, PGA (SCPGA CEO/Executive Director as she is aware of the last several years of negotiations with TopGolf at this facility as well as regionally) and Craig Kessler, SCGA Director of Government Affairs (Craig wrote the attached document when the original deal was signed as a reference. Craig also more recently met with the leadership at Westchester Golf Course to assure that El Segundo had a golf course to play their home matches, which even as a neighboring city facility they were happy to do in support).

The short term negotiations to keep our girls season rolling smoothly is important. In the long run, It would seem that the development of an oversight committee (as apparently was originally discussed in the doc below) to make sure we don't have to have these same conversations when the next batch of new Topgolf people are enshrined to be important for the long term health of all youth golf activities at the greater Lakes at El Segundo Golf Facility as was envisioned when the deal with TopGolf was inked.

Thank you and I am looking forward to progress supporting our golfing kids!!!

As a parent of a female student athlete who is participating in Golf representing El Segundo High School, I am seeing a difference this year in the level of facility access for the Girls Golf Team during this season. I always thought there was a partnership with Top Golf and the City of El Segundo in access and building a relationship with our school district's students.

I am not seeing this come to fruition and there is a great deal of difference versus last year. If the El Segundo Unified School District cannot get the support by way of the City and that "partnership" with Top Golf, what is the purpose of our girls participating

in a sport in which access and ability cannot be improved upon. I have copied the El Segundo Superintendent, The El Segundo School Board, The Ed Foundation and the City of El Segundo because I had the privilege and honor of attending the City/School Affairs Sub Committee on September 6, 2023 at 5:00 at City Hall in the Executive Conference Room, which was interesting and informative all at once (You all do not want to hear about that) :). The School/City has always had a partnership and of course they deal with Joint Use Agreements which are suppose to support our student body. That partnership and future becomes rather complicated, when the City of El Segundo and Top Golf cannot nurture our girls and albeit, boys as well, golf teams. The girls have a very short season that literally lasts until 10/12/2023 (excluding League). I would really like to see our girls and boys back at the Lakes Top Golf to enrich their craft and love for the game. I hope the parties can reach out to Top Golf and make this happen because it does look a certain way that our girls are getting the you know what end of the stick. I do not want any of our girls to feel Corporate America does not value them and that the City of El Segundo cannot make these type of partnerships come to a realized effort on behalf of the El Segundo Unified School District, which could bring valid considerations of future agreements, allocations of funds and like kind agreements for the benefit of our students. I have a tee time at Westchester @ 9:30 am, but it looks like I will have to cancel and attend the Coffee With The Principal tomorrow in lieu to get clarity on the issue. Parents spend a great deal monetarily on this sport and if the district and Top Golf are unwilling to act with haste, please do not collect the ASB Fee and Transportation Fee to set our girls for failure. Coach March and Coach Lauren, THANK YOU BOTH for your continued support and zeal for the game and our children. I am watching and I SEE you both. Incredible!!!!

As an avid golfer myself who has been playing the Lakes for 10+ years, and who followed the conversion to TopGolf closely there are a couple of outstanding questions I would like to get clarity on. I am hoping the answers can be provided here, or if not, if you can kindly point me in the right direction of who to reach out to.

My questions pertain to the ability for the high school golfers to play and hit balls at Top Golf at a discounted rate. This is something that was discussed all along and I would like to know if there is now an established process for our kids to get affordable access to play the Lakes on days / times when the team does not have scheduled practice. Most local courses participate in the Youth On Course program where \$5 green fees are made available. Prior to TopGolf taking over there was a monthly card available for kids but to my knowledge no such program is available. The level of dedication of our girls and boys team will result in many of them seeking out playing opportunities outside of the team practice hours so getting a clear understanding of what agreements are in place in a timely manner is much needed. Westchester has been a great partner / supporter to our kids and it would be great for El Segundo if the kids could be awarded equal access to The Lakes at affordable prices.

Hello all! I wanted to thank Mr. Slack for showing some genuine interest in his daughter and our ESHS girls golf team. I also what to thank those who have helped get the girls team to where it is today! I have been on the forefront supporting and growing the game of golf in El Segundo for many years. In specific, my experience in attempting to further girls and women's golf here in El Segundo continues to be challenging.

Since Topgolf opened, I have been in various conversations and negotiations not only to ensure what was contracted for our juniors happened, but also to see what greater support TopGolf could give to a 1st ever girls golf program. In the teams first season we were met with extremely high priced quotes for fundraisers, a small discount for course usage and very limited venue access. Not to mention that all of that could be canceled anytime due to facility buyouts. At times, the girls would be shuffled to different areas of the venue after it was agreed that they would only practice on the 1st floor close to the practice area to limit exposure to alcohol use etc... "Additional support" for the team would have to be revisited after Topgolf had "turned a profit." It would appear by all metrics that TopGolf has made more than a little profit (to my understanding, El Segundo Topgolf achieved the most revenue of any TopGolf in the country except for the Vegas location).

Needless to say the progression of girls golf in El Segundo has been difficult and there will be more golf teams and programs entering the mix in the short term future. In addition to the girls team, we now have a large ES High School boys golf team starting in the Spring, as well as a middle school "developmental program" we have been working to develop.

I am cc'ing a few more sources who have either assisted in or followed the progression of this subject: Josh Alpert, PGA (long time El Segundo resident, Youth Academy Coach to several Gundo players and in our greater South Bay community, also the SCPGA Section Player Development Chair over the past 2 years) Nikki Gatch, PGA (SCPGA CEO/Executive Director as she is aware of the last several years of negotiations with TopGolf at this facility as well as regionally) and Craig Kessler, SCGA Director of Government Affairs (Craig wrote the attached document when the original deal was signed as a reference. Craig also more recently met with the leadership at Westchester Golf Course to assure that El Segundo had a golf course to play their home matches, which even as a neighboring city facility they were happy to do in support).

The short term negotiations to keep our girls season rolling smoothly is important. In the long run, It would seem that the development of an oversight committee (as apparently was originally discussed in the doc below) to make sure we don't have to have these same conversations when the next batch of new Topgolf people are enshrined to be important for the long term health of all youth golf activities at the greater Lakes at El Segundo Golf Facility as was envisioned when the deal with TopGolf was inked.
