Speakers are not specifically listed. Can you share who will be speaking?

I will do my best to be there tomorrow (I have to be in Irvine most of the day).

I am very concerned about the safety and security of the Jewish community in El Segundo and I'm very interested to understand what the plan is to ensure that protests like today's do not devolve into what happened today in the future with the violence (accosting Employees, blocking rights of way and such), the rocks (which could easily be used violently and not just to block the roadway) and vandalism.

Were arrests made (the media is reporting that no arrests were made - even for the vandalism)?
