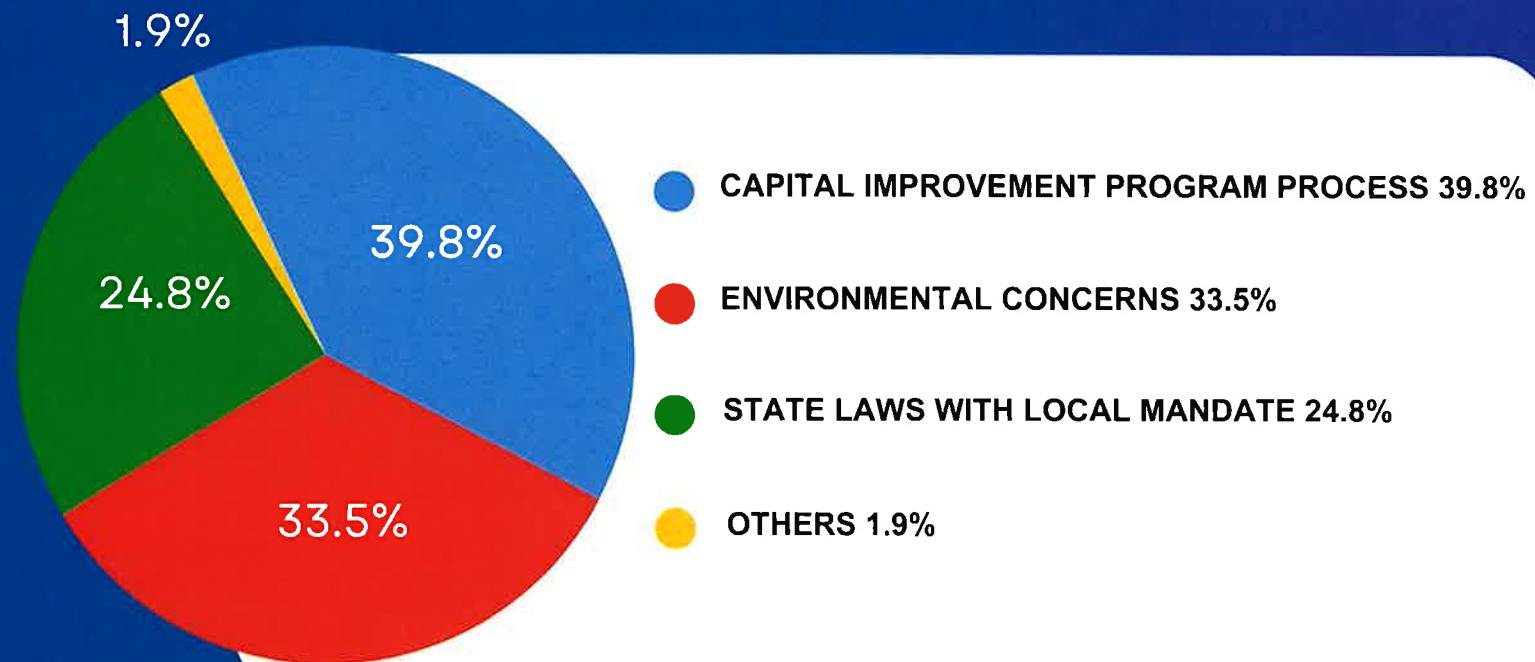

QUALIFICATIONS

- **Must be at least thirteen (13) years and under the age of nineteen (19) years**
- **Residing with their parent(s) or guardian(s) within the City of El Segundo or be a registered attendee of El Segundo, Vistamar, or Da Vinci High School.**
- **Participants must have written parental consent.**

STRUCTURE

- **Promote and accept applications August – End of September**
- **Eleven (11) members**
- **One (1) year term without limits**
- **Meetings once per month**
- **First meeting in October**
- **First update to City Council in early 2025**

RECOMMENDED COUNCIL ACTION

- **Authorize the establishment of a Youth Advisory Council as an educational program for local high school students.**
- **Authorize City staff to conduct interviews and select Youth Advisory Council members.**
