General Plan Implementation

- State Law does not have specific guidance
- The City's report contains the following sections:
 - Community Development Department activity update
 - Progress on each General Plan Element



Community Development Activity

- 1,787 persons assisted at the counter
- 1,540 building permit applications processed (22 new units)
- 4,332 inspections completed
- 22 planning entitlement applications processed
- 14 Planning Commission meetings conducted
- 228 Code violation cases initiated
