# 3. General Plan Implementation and Annual General Plan Housing Element Progress Reports

Principal Planner Paul Samaras presented a brief presentation regarding the General Plan Implementation and Annual Housing Element Progress the city made in 2023, focusing on General Plan elements: land use, circulation, and housing. He summarized the progress the city has made with all eleven Housing Element Programs and highlighted that Community Development Activity includes 1,540 processed permit applications, 4,332 inspections completed, 22 planning entitlement applications processed, and 2285 code violation cases initiated.

- Commissioner Maggay inquired if there is a similar type of program as
  the insulation program by LAX that could be applied for with Hyperion
  and the infiltration systems. Paul advised that the insulation program
  by LAX was obtained through a lawsuit/court order initiated by City
  Council and as of right now City Council has taken other approaches
  with Hyperion.
- Commissioner Maggay requested additional information regarding fair housing program. Paul stated that the city's aim of the fair housing program is to take actions that promote nondiscrimination when it comes to housing and the city committed in doing so by working with LA County Development Authority. One way this is being achieved is by making the resources LA County has available for residents via the city's website. City is also doing outreach programs in different neighborhoods on a quarterly basis to ensure all resident groups are

#### being reached.

Michael Allen, Community Development Director, reminded Planning Commissioners that Form 700 is due to City Clerk and has physical copies available for completion. As for the gateway sign, the project may be going back to City Council for contract award in the near future.
