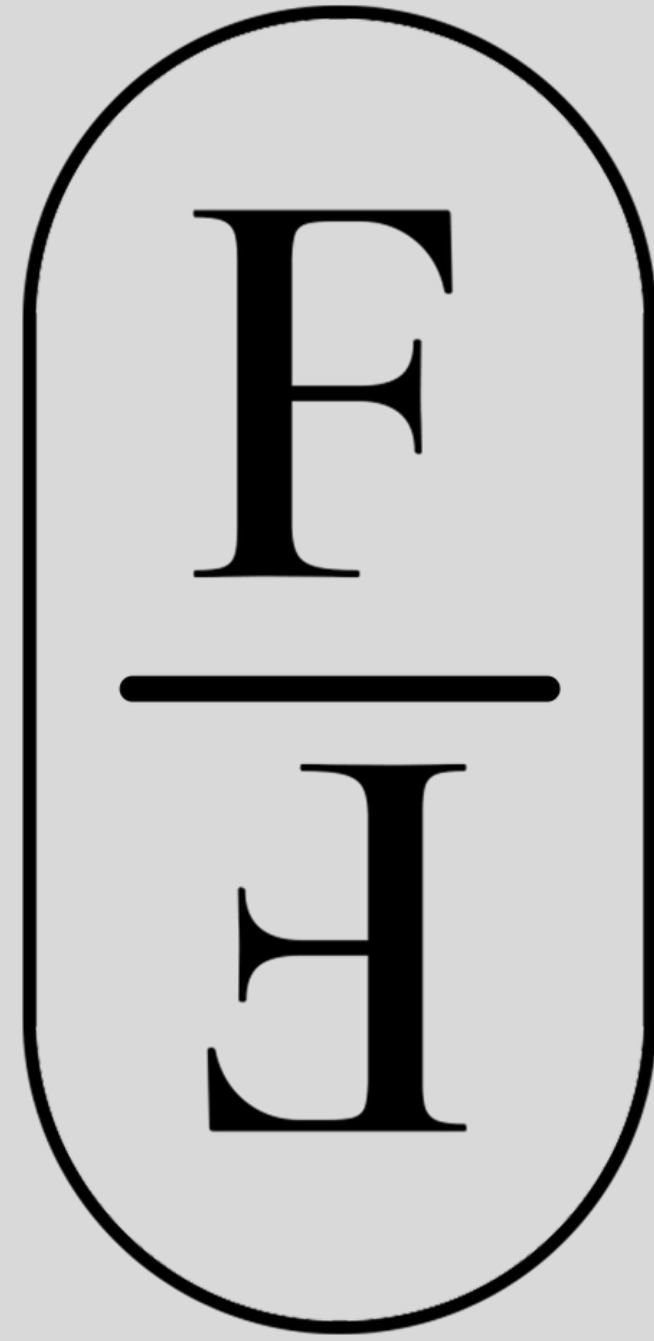
Cultural Arts Coordinator Randy Niessen commented on the progress of various Capital Improvement Projects such as the Plunge and the Lighting project.

E: FOUR BOLT PATTERN

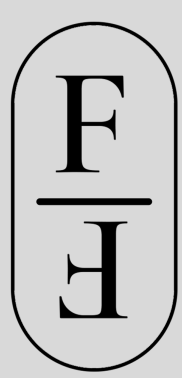


NOTE:

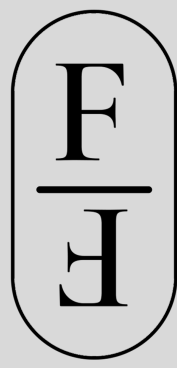

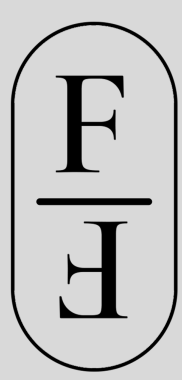


This sculpture is a little more complicated to fix after graffiti.
