# Background

- The Planning Commission: Five El Segundo residents appointed by City Council.
- The Planning Commission's major roles:
  - Affirm Director decisions on AUPs, Adjustments, and Interpretations
  - Approve land use applications, including conditional use permits (CUPs), subdivisions, and variances.
  - Make recommendations to City Council on Zone Code amendments, General Plan amendments, adoption of specific plans, and related development projects.
  - Provide input to staff on Planning-related matters.

#### Completed

- Housing Element community meetings
  - o Four at the Planning Commission level since Sept. 2021
  - o Certified by the State on July 15, 2024
- Six Study Sessions with Planning staff:
  - Smoky Hollow Specific Plan (SHSP)
    - o Contributed to the SHSP update
  - Three regarding the Downtown Specific Plan (DTSP)
    - o Contributed to the updated DTSP
  - Two regarding development standards for the R-3 and Mixed-Use overlays

#### Completed Cont.

- One El Segundo South Campus Specific Plan (ESSCSP)
  Amendment
- One General Plan Amendment and one Zone Change
  Implementing Housing Element Program No. 6 and Program No. 9
- One General Plan Annual Implementation and Housing Element Progress Report

#### Completed Cont.

- Five Zone Text Amendments
  - o Three that directly implemented the Housing Element and were instrumental in obtaining certification from HCD, which included
    - o Micro units
    - o Density bonus provisions
    - o Increase density in key areas of the city, and
    - o Creating a reasonable accommodations process for individuals with disabilities
